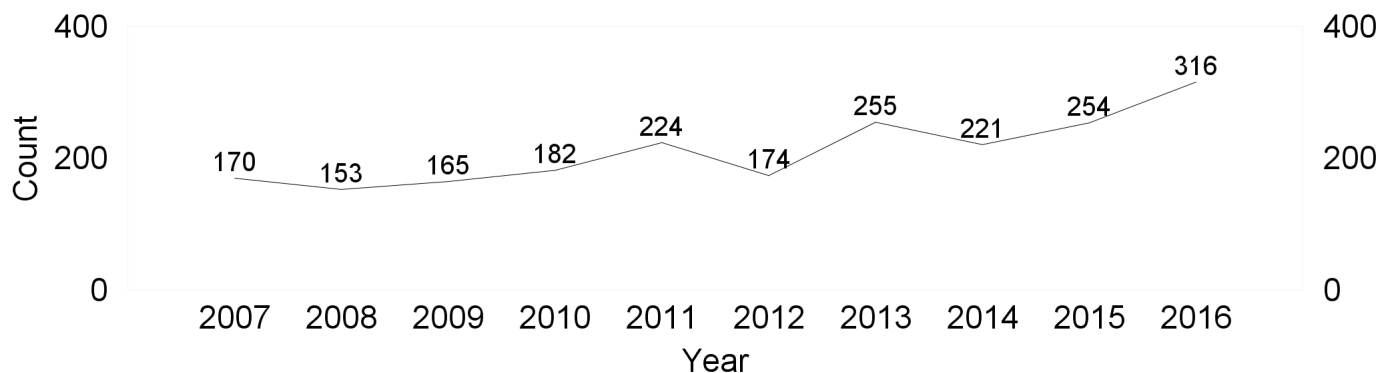


Chlamydia Cases by Year, Josephine, 2007–2016



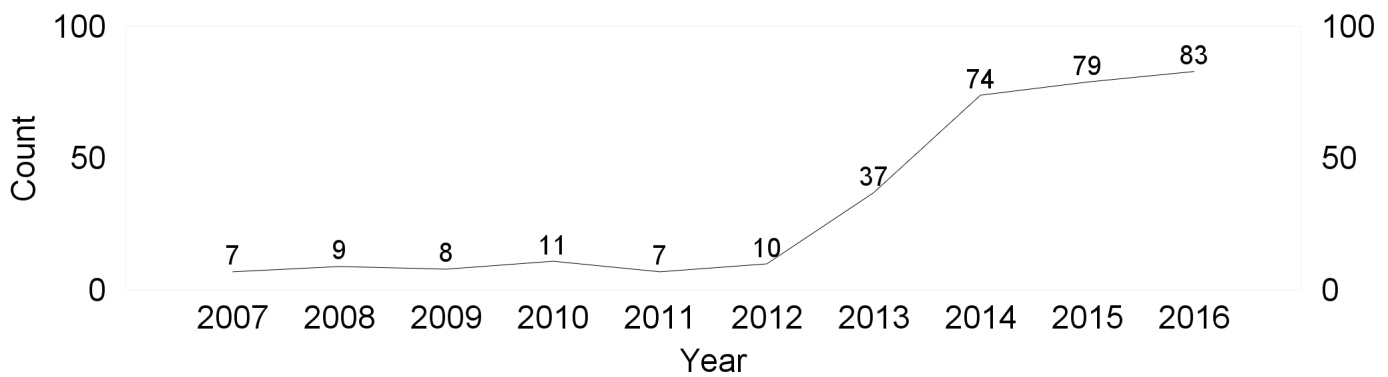

## Gonorrhea Cases by Year, Josephine, 2007–2016



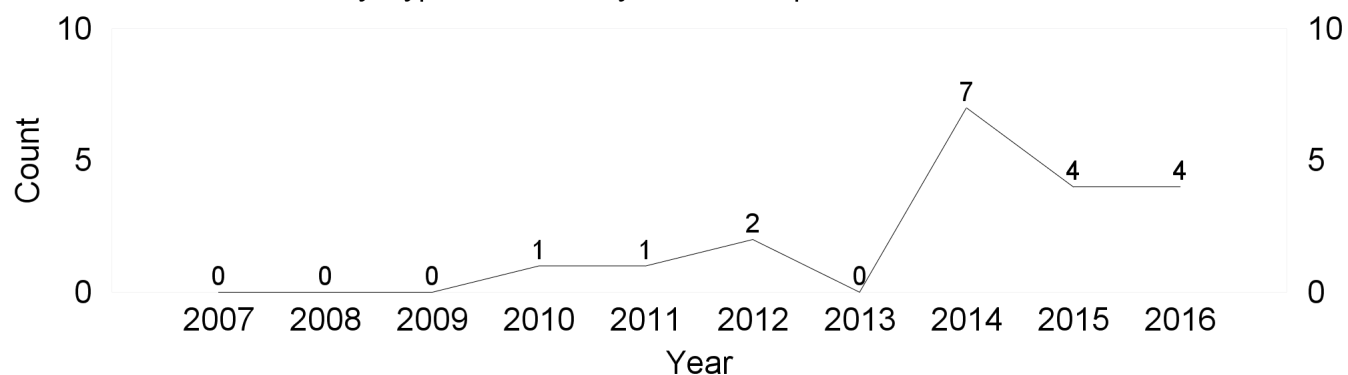
