Partnering with Community



## CATEGORIES

Mini Grant funds went towards implementation, or a direct service in the community.

Examples of projects include:

- stakeholder/community engagement
- harm reduction for with individuals with drug use (syringe services, hepatitis C, HIV testing)
- vaccine storage
- outreach clinics to offer Hep B/C and HIV screening and influenza Hep A/B vaccine for people experiencing homelessness or incarceration
- harm reduction (sharps containers)
- harm reduction for individuals with drug use (syringe exchange, HIV/STI testing and Hep C testing) and stakeholder/community engagement


