- Salem Hospital




- **Willamette Valley Medical Center** is actively testing and hoping to go live within the next few months

- Saint Alphonsus and Sky Lakes are also in early development


New Feature - Duplicate ELR button for Gonorrhea/Chlamydia ELRs

- You now have the ability to duplicate ELRs that come in with paired tests (e.g., Gonorrhea/Chlamydia). Go to the More Tab of the ELR Patient Detail and use the Duplicate CD ELR button (see figure below).

No objections for Mid-Columbia, Silverton, Asante, and Salem to stop faxing, pending final OK from Kathy from Klamath re: Asante.








The persons under monitoring don't have contacts; only suspect cases have contacts.


Developer updates – Tom – 20 min Location data entry in Outbreaks

Pop-ups around location data have been replaced by check boxes to meet National Foodborne Outbreak Reporting requirements. This is on the basic tab of the outbreaks report database



Home screen timed refresh - should speed up loading of home page -- June

We've received a lot of negative feedback about performance lags when navigating back to the home screen. The navigation is dependent on various parameters, including number of cases that need to be refreshed on your home screen filter, new ELRs showing up on your home screen, etc.




TIP: Pare down your home screen settings to just what you need to increase performance.

Current county – feature removed




STD updates – Irina – 10 min
