Have had some issues with disruptions, for example; Asante (Rogue Valley primarily) when we had an ftp outage in June, the reconnection didn't work – turned on again this Monday 11th August. New hepatitis labs on old cases

Hepatitis--adding “new” ELRs to old cases, when doing this you might need to go to the clinical tab and enter a fake onset date so that the case is counted in the correct year.

The state uses onset date to count cases for the general communicable diseases (basically everything except the STDs), therefore an onset date will be calculated. It is calculated as two days before lab test date, or 7 days before the LHD report date. So unless you insert date into the onset field, it will calculate an onset from the new ELR lab specimen date. This really only applies to older cases since we did not enter lab data on hepatitis cases before Orpheus.

Patrick—Processing Syphilis Reactors

We have not forgotten that we want to make syphilis reactors all view so that you can find these reactor records.

Patrick reviewed how to process ELRs by finding if the person exists in Orpheus like processing other ELRs.

Sherri (Morrow) stated that she searches ELR reports, looks up in Orpheus, and if not her county, transfers. If you find the person in Orpheus call the State STD program and see if a reactor record exists.

Juan (Mult) said that if the patient is seen in a Mult STD clinic, they will have already started a case for them – even if there it is an out of county case. Trying to avoid duplicate persons, Juan said that they go to the more tab and add the other county to the case record so that they can view it.

When there is blood work for any patient, it always goes in the Reactor

If you enter an onset date it updates the field at the top of the screen. If you add a new ELR report to an old Hepatitis record you should enter an onset date to be LHD report date- 7 days.

June- Check to see if this in the data entry instructions for hepatitis. We would like you to enter a fake onset date on the clinical tab- to be 7 days before the LHD report date.

Need to create a second disease group so that syphilis reactors can be viewable by all users. In the meantime you need to call the state to find out their reactor status.

Once you have interpreted the labs, new case records are created for each NEW infection.

Once you open the “Reactor” page, the stage of syphilis is always “700”.

If there are out of state labs on someone, state is entering these into the reactor record.

Juan (Mult) should the Epi on record be the person working the case?
Patrick: Yes. If possible.

Treatment would be on the case record.
State or county can assign the reactor or the case to the person currently working on the case. If multiple reactor records exist – please enter this into the notes – new rpr and who you assigned it to.
Recommend that users update the reactor address so that if you create a case from the reactor record it would have the current address for the person

When working with another county on a syphilis reactor or case record – the user should add the other county to the more tab so that they can see the record.

For a reactor status will be no case and all lab reports will be documented on the syphilis reactor record. These lab results are viewable on the syphilis case report but the lab results should all be on the reactor record. This allows easier interpretation of the reports. The only fields that

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There are updated investigative guidelines (IG) to determine case status. We are aligning with the CDC definitions. Most cases would be presumptive unless there has been a test that has identified the actual organism. Please refer to the IG for clarification.

Contacts

Much discussion about many errors and glitches with transferring contacts between counties. If you are unable to see the county from which the contact was transferred you cannot see the contact information. June demonstrated how to add the county to the more tab of the actual case. Not sure if the issue arises while the contact is actually being created or somewhere else. Changing the county on the contact record triggers a transfer. You are prompted to indicate why. This should be a temporary solution which will override the permissions - there is no reason why information cannot be shared around a case. Once a contact is transferred the originating county can not even view the contact any longer. The originating county should be retained.

Mary (Benton) noted that the user list seems to be out-of-date so unsure who to contact.

of the other tabs need to be entered for syphilis reactors.

Update the url for the syphilis IG

Please make sure that your user settings – email and phone number are up to date and accurate as this will be used to contact you. Suggestion was made to always add the other county on the more page settings, so that the case can be shared. Also, nice to send the user in the other county a little note, either e-mail or via the “To-Do” list to give them a heads-up. There is a primary check box when there are multiple people in the counties – can chose a primary communicator and let tech team know who that is.

If you decide to transfer a contact, please follow up by communicating with whomever you are transferring a contact to. The best scenario is to add the county to the more tab for the case so that everyone can share the record and they can update the contact tab with information about the out of county contact. At this time it does not seem possible to add additional counties to the actual contact record at this time. There is no more tab for a contact.
