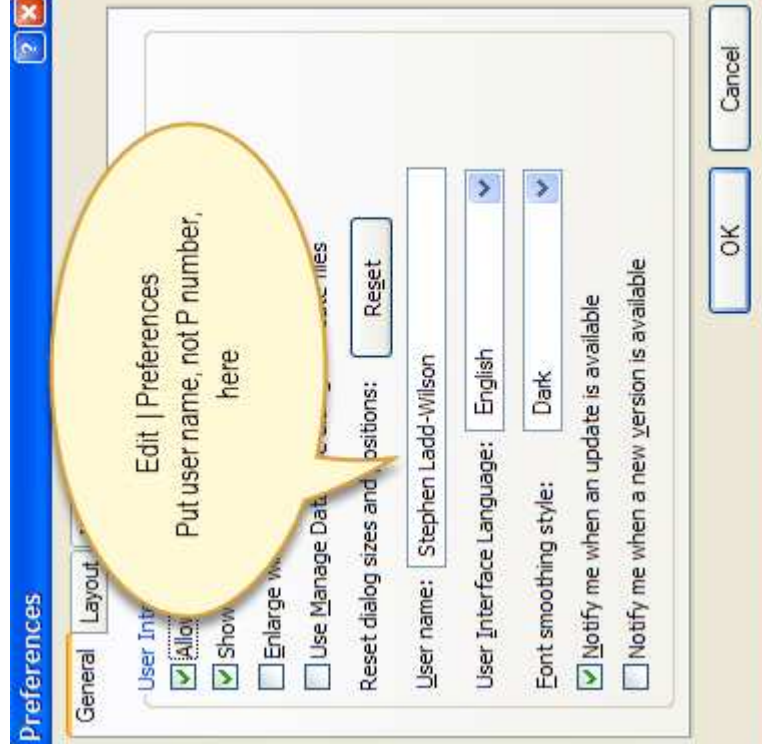
Topic		Action Items
1.	Overall update – Stephen Security Audits -- Need to follow up with Josephine, Polk, Warm Springs, Morrow, Union, Curry, Wallowa	Kirk from Polk to follow up with Stephen re: their ORP, who is no longer with there.
2.	Citrix update – Jennifer - They've been working on upgrading the Citrix environment over the past year.	Users to set their preferences and account information once in Orpheus.

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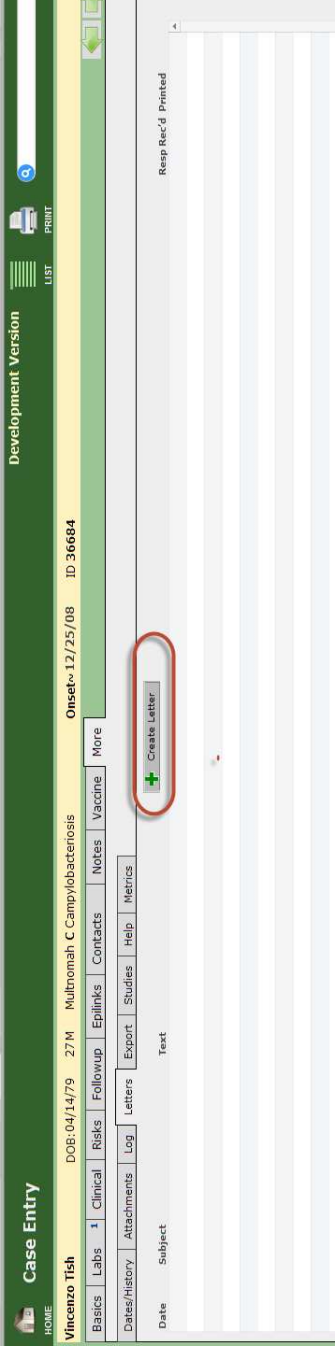
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3.	ELR update -- Michelle- - Duplicate ELR faxes - Providence Update - They're interested in stopping their duplicate faxing. Michelle asked for feedback. Michelle to follow up with Lindsey; ELRs aren't capturing specimen source. - Mary asked about any other data around faxes? Michelle wants to know what Lab is also sending faxes, e.g., Providence. If they don't fit into the category provided by Michelle, then just say "Other." Mary also stated that she prefers to get the faxes, as they provide a little more data than the ELR. Why doesn't Michelle (the state) want the Labs to also fax? The state wants the labs to provide all the information that counties receive in faxes, also in ELR. If labs are sending more data via fax than via ELR, they need to amend the ELR with the information. Our overarching goal is to get all the information electronically. The issue with receiving negative results is a bit tricky, as labs are not mandated to report negative results, except to the clinician/county ordering the tests, in which case they should be reporting directly to you anyway. Karen (Crook) - Hepatitis panels often include the negatives. They don't want to lose the negative results. Michelle agreed that the labs should be sending the results of the entire panel -- negatives and positives. Labs are generally excited about the notion of trading off faxing for ELRs. Perry (Multnomah) - When matching ELRs to a related case, often times he cannot see the case, what is he supposed to do? Either ignore the ELR, as it will probably need to be linked with a case that Perry cannot see, or call the tech team	Please count your faxes though the end of May so that we can report to CDC the burden of duplicate faxes. . 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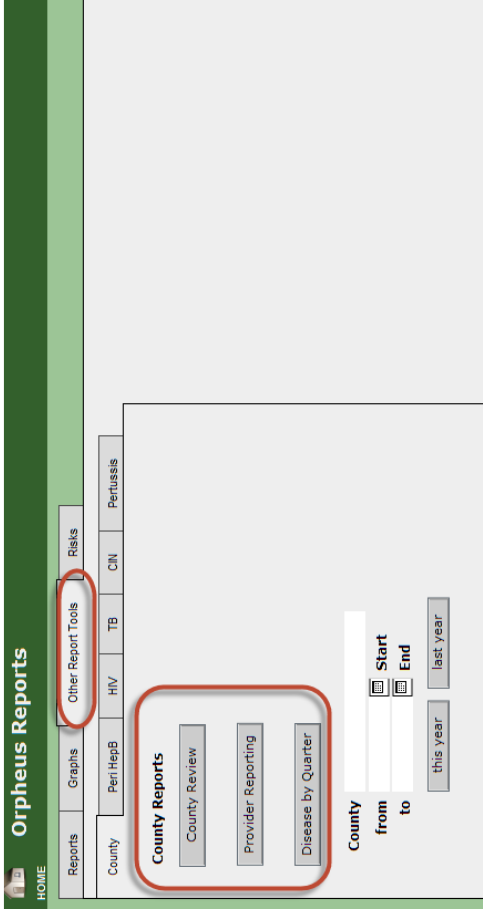

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	 Q. Why do I get so few reports when running chlamydia? STDs generally don't have onset date listed, and the reporting module defaults to onset date. You need to use Report Date instead of Onset Date when running reports on STDs. Also, Disease by Quarter Report incorporates a Date of Record field, which incorporates all the dates.

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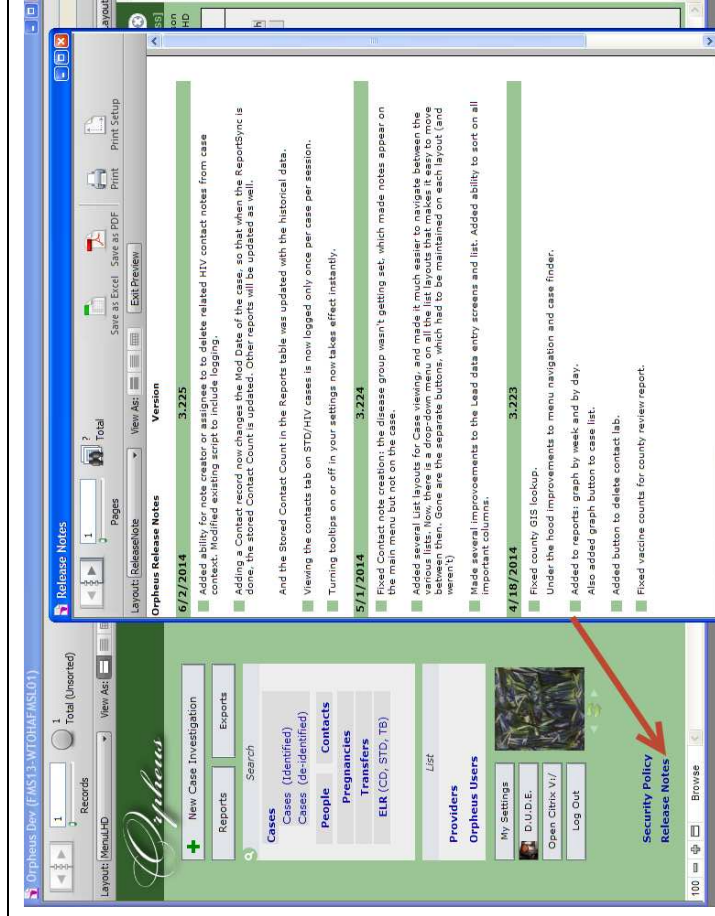

7.	Outbreaks – Tom If your pathogen is set to unknown, it may automatically get changed to norovirus if certain other criteria are set. Conversely, if you have norovirus checked along with other criteria, there's a possibility that it may get switched to back to unknown. Outbreaks only does this for gastroenteritis and norovirus; it looks at the confirmed count, the specimen count (fecal and non-fecal): - If $\geq$ lab confirmed, then norovirus. (A dialog box will tell you that it's being changed). - If there are no specimens, then it will apply the Kaplan criteria (half the symptomatic persons had vomiting & mediation duration is between 12 and 48 hours & and no bloody diarrhea)

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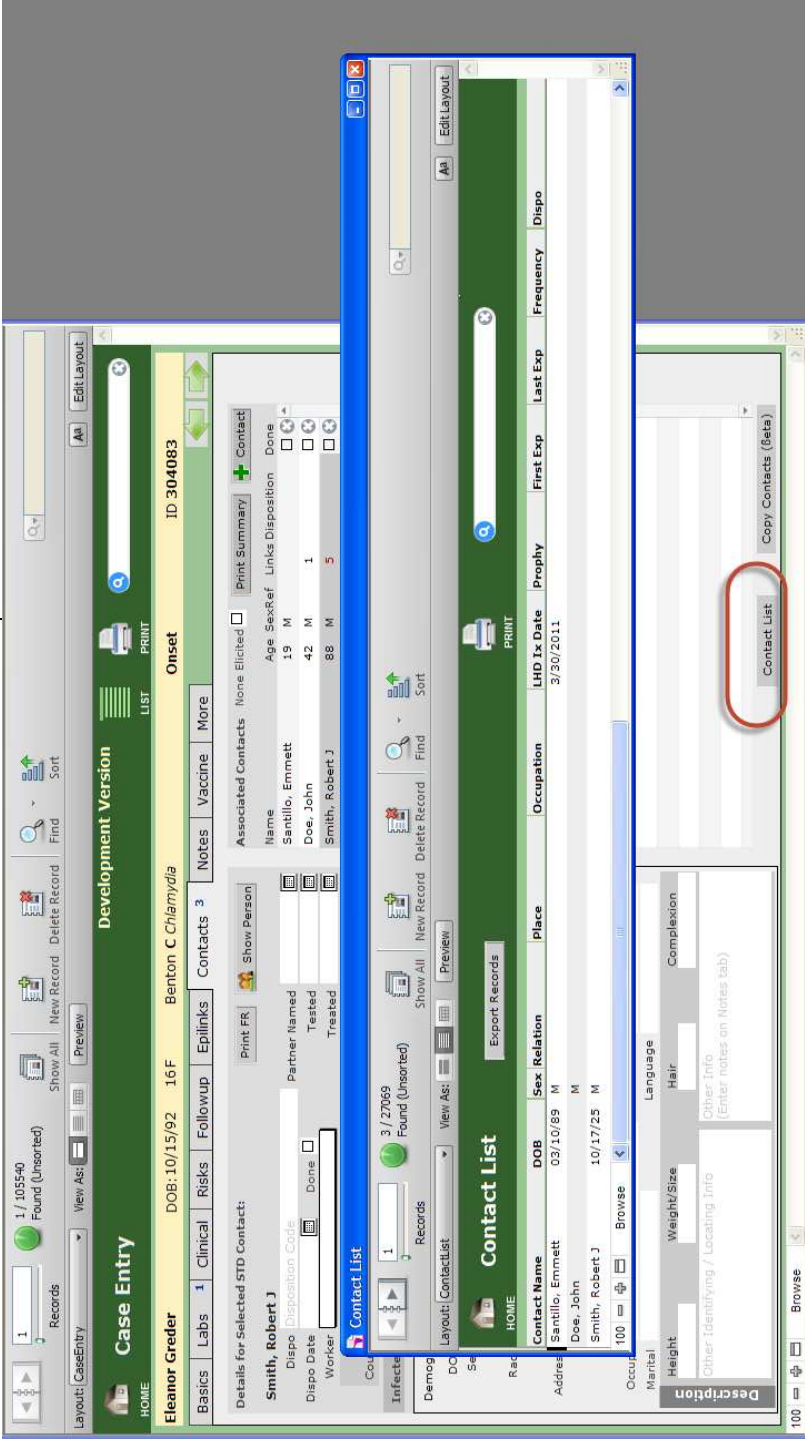
