

North Central – Wondering if you can refer providers to report online – YES, you can refer providers to the website to report online.




Maintaining Providers in Orpheus – June – 10 min




also like feedback on fields that are not useful. This did not ever really get fully developed.

Important fields are type of reporter (Hospital, Clinic, Provider, Long Term Care), Active is also important because some providers become inactive, we would not want to link cases with inactive providers. You know who is still active in your communities. When have a provider email please enter this. Michelle mentioned email communications could be sent securely and answer some case specific questions. More tab has the cases linked to this provider.

You can export a provider list to clean up and then go back into Orpheus and clean them up in Orpheus. If you would want to clean up the excel sheet be sure to export the ID field for the provider and send the file back to the tech team. Please ask before you go this route. This can be used to contact fax, send letters, or contact providers when managing cases.



Instead of a long list of reports you can now search for what one you want if you know the name. The date of record has been added as field you can search on. The advanced checkbox is now called search more fields. The triennial review and the clean data reports are now on the main page instead on the other report tools. Some other reports have been moved around and the new theme is part of the Orpheus interface redesign to make use of new features available in Filemaker and also harmonize with the STD module.
