Subject: COVID-19 and TB Services

Dear LPHA:

Until the situation with COVID-19 resolves the following is recommended:

- 1- TB drug shortages are increasing. Currently there are shortages of ethambutol and rifapentine. **Order all the drugs needed at diagnosis to complete a patient's LTBI or TB disease treatment.**
- 2- Utilize electronic DOT and monthly telehealth visits when patient safety allows for this. See Multnomah County documents: [Mult. Co. COVID-19 Messaging and PPE for Home Visits](#) and [Mult. Co. TB Care Priorities for Home Visits](#) for assistance with decision making. Contact me if you are unable to do DOT for any reason.
- 3- LPHAs are not required to treat LTBI unless the patient is a case contact or B-waiver immigrant. Consider postponing LTBI treatment for other patients if needed.
- 4- Defer evaluation and treatment of B-waiver immigrants if current resources do not allow for follow-up.
