

Measles is Spreading

If you have any of these symptoms, go to the hospital immediately. Tell the emergency room you're on your way.



A hard time breathing or breathing faster than normal.

Signs of severe dehydration (dizziness, urinating less than usual).



Confusion, decreased alertness, or severe weakness.

Young children: a blue color around the mouth, crying without making tears, unusually low energy, or severe loss of appetite.



Calling the ER in advance helps protect your loved ones and the medical staff treating you and your family.
