

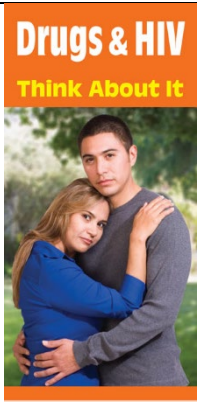
List of OPRP Approved Documents
