Syphilis Testing:

Screening Cascade vs. RPR Titer Only



To Diagnose Syphilis:

- Order Screening Cascade
 - » RPR with Reflex to Titer and Treponemal Confirmation or Treponemal Test with Reflex to RPR and Titer
 - » Sequence of tests depends on lab
 - » Initial positive result needs to be confirmed by second test

To Monitor Syphilis Antibodies:

- Order RPR with Reflex to Titer
 - » Only order if patient has a known history of syphilis and documentation of past positive treponemal test is available

Syphilis Testing Tips for Labs and Providers



Laboratory tips

- If only RPR is ordered, check with provider to see if there is documentation of previous positive treponemal test
- If no positive treponemal test on record, suggest syphilis screening cascade: screening with reflex to confirmatory test

Provider tips

- For ED/urgent care/OB patients, syphilis screening cascade should be the default order
- If patient reports syphilis history, contact your local health department to review previous RPR titers and treatment
