


# Water System Service Area Boundaries

### **Water System Service Areas**

- The geographic area that receives water from a PWS
- Includes all homes, buildings, and connections served by the PWS
- A service area boundary refers to the polygon, or shape, that creates a border around all connections



### Why are service area boundaries important?

- Emergency response and preparation
- Identify disadvantaged communities
  - Prioritize financial and technical assistance
- Information sharing
  - Interagency collaboration
  - Enable public to determine where their water comes from
  - Facilitate academic research
