

# Free Well Water Testing at Thurston High School



For the past 15 years, Springfield Public School's Water and Energy Learning Lab program has facilitated a free well testing program at Thurston High School.

Thurston High School's Community Water Testing Lab is now accepting appointments for the 2017 school year. Tests are performed by students and results are mailed or emailed to customers within one week. Although the lab is not certified, students are trained to produce accurate and reliable results.

- Appointments are required and spaces are limited, so please call us at 541.744.4140.
- Accuracy of testing requires the use of sampling kit provided by the program.

The sampling kit contains one sealed bacteria bottle, one 500ml bottle, two labels, and detailed instructions, including a map of Thurston High School. Well water samples are generally collected the day of your appointment and returned between 7-9am to Thurston High School's water testing lab.
