Amend OAR 333-150-0000: Adoption of the 2022 US Department of Health and Human Services, Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Food Code by reference with additions and amendments. The Food Sanitation Rules (OAR 333-150-0000) are currently based upon the 2009 FDA Food Code, and the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is updating Oregon's food safety standards to the most current version. Amendments to OAR 333-150-0000 provide Oregon-specific changes to the 2022 FDA Food Code. The 2022 FDA Food Code is the most current, science-based national standard for food safety. These proposed rules also implement provisions of Senate Bill 90, which implements a limit on food service establishments providing plastic straws to consumers unless requested (Oregon Laws 2019, chapter 362), which were passed during the 2019 Oregon Legislative Session. These rules were originally adopted by the OHA on January 1, 2020, but were inadvertently removed from the rule text in a subsequent rulemaking. The requirements have been in place since January 1, 2020 according to the Food Sanitation Rules.

The Agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing the negative economic impact of the rule on business.
