Mission: HHGP's mission is to improve housing conditions and health outcomes for low-income Oregonians, including communities of color, immigrant and refugee communities, LGBTQ community, communities experiencing health inequities, tribal communities, rural communities, remote communities, coastal communities, communities with limited infrastructure and other communities traditionally underrepresented in public processes and adversely harmed by environmental and health hazards, including seniors, youth, and persons with disabilities.

Vision: HHGP seeks to become a central resource for healthy homes repair across the state to help eliminate health disparities of low-income Oregonians.

Values: HHGP is committed to centering equity, racial justice, diversity, and cultural responsiveness in its delivery, while acknowledging that there are institutional, systemic, and structural barriers that perpetuate inequity and have silenced the voices of communities over time.

Intended Impacts: HHGP aims to improve health outcomes for residents who live in repaired/ rehabilitated housing; preserve affordability and availability of existing housing stock by addressing deferred property maintenance issues; and help low-income homeowners avoid displacement in the face of short-term crises through access to home repair funds.
