

Arsenic Level	Water Use	Recommendations
10 ppb or less	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SAFE for drinking, cooking and all other domestic uses 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Test well regularly
Between 10 and 99 ppb	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NOT SAFE for drinking, mixing into beverages, cooking, or washing fruits/vegetables • NOT SAFE for watering pets • SAFE for all other domestic uses, including bathing, washing dishes/laundry, irrigation 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use bottled water (or water filtration approved for arsenic treatment) for drinking, cooking, washing fruits & vegetables, and watering pets • Supervise children to minimize swallowing water while bathing, brushing teeth, etc.
Between 100 and 499 ppb	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same restrictions as above • NOT SAFE for irrigating gardens – arsenic may build up in soil over time • SAFE for all other domestic uses 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Test well regularly (test pre & post-treatment if using filtration system)
500 ppb and greater	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NOT SAFE for any domestic uses 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact local or state health department or Drinking Water Program
