<p>HB2754   Adds requirements for diagnostic audiology facilities to refer children with hearing loss to a health care provider for CMV testing by 21 days of age. Adds requirement of OHA to provide schedule for screening, diagnosis and referral as well as to compile and disseminate information to providers and the public.</p>	<p>Amends ORS 433.321:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When a diagnostic facility detects hearing loss, it shall provide to the parent or guardian materials and refer the parent or guardian to a health care provider for the purpose of diagnosing whether the child has CMV;</li> <li>• OHA shall provide to all Oregon hospitals and birth centers a schedule for conducting hearing screening tests and referring parents and guardians to diagnostic facilities and to health care providers such that a diagnosis and testing for CMV is completed with 21 days of the newborn child’s date of birth;</li> <li>• OHA shall compile information on the following re: congenital CMV - transmission, signs and symptoms, potential complications, treatment and management.
