Objective

To provide commercial health benefit plan partners a monthly standardized update about the latest developments in Family Connects Oregon (FCO).

Status Update

- 2025-2027 Family Connects Oregon <u>Commercial Rate Announcement</u> and <u>Coding</u>
 <u>Guidance</u> are final! Thank you for your support in this year-long project!
 - Beginning July 1, 2025, the FCO commercial case rate for will be \$1,856. The case rate for a Pre-IHV is \$427. In the case of families with multiple infants (e.g. twins, triplets), the case rate is \$297 per additional infant.
 - Recruitment for the 2027-2029 commercial rate setting committee will begin in the Summer of 2026. Stay tuned!
 - Action item for commercial insurance carriers: Commercial insurance carriers
 will need to update their FCO Fee Schedules to reflect this rate increase. If you need
