Objective

To provide commercial health benefit plan partners a monthly standardized update about the latest developments in Family Connects Oregon (FCO).

Status Update

- The 2026 FCO Commercial Insurance Carrier Quarterly Call calendar invites went out late July! The 2026 Meeting Dates are (start time 1:05p):
 - o Tuesday, March 17, 2026
 - Tuesday, June 16, 2026
 - o Tuesday, September 15, 2026
 - Tuesday, November 17, 2026

- As of July 1, 2025, carriers will need to discontinue contracts with Crook County and transfer contracts over to Jefferson County, who will be serving the Crook County area.
- The 2025-2027 Family Connects Oregon Case Rate went into effect on July 1, 2025.
 - Beginning July 1, 2025, the FCO <u>case rate</u> for commercial claims is \$1856. The
 case rate for Pre-IHVs only is \$427. In the case of families with multiple infants (e.g.
 twins, triplets), the case rate is \$297 per additional infant. Additional details can be
 find in the <u>FCO Coding Guidance</u>.
- Our next commercial insurance carrier call is on Tuesday, September 16 at 1:05p on Microsoft Teams.
- FCO Site Launch Updates
 - Yamhill County Public Health began offering services on January 1, 2025.
 - Polk County Health Department began offering services on February 1, 2025.
 - United Community Action Network (UCAN; Douglas County) began offering services on February 1, 2025.
 - Coos Health and Wellness is planning to offer services in January 2026.

- August 2, 1776 In Philadelphia, most of the 55 members of the Continental Congress signed the parchment copy of the Declaration of Independence.
- o August 4, 1961 President Barack Obama is born in Honolulu, Hawaii.
- o August 5, 1962 Film star Marilyn Monroe dies at age 36.
- August 11, 1841 Frederick Douglass spoke before an audience in the North for the first time on Nantucket Island.
- August 14, 1935 President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed the Social Security Act establishing the system which guarantees pensions to those who retire at age 65.
