## **Status Update**

- In accordance with the state <u>rules</u>, the Reimbursement Advisory Committee is gearing up to determine Family Connects Oregon's 2025-2027 commercial insurance carrier case rate! We will start recruiting for the Reimbursement Advisory Committee this summer with applicants being notified early fall. The 2025-2027 Reimbursement Advisory Committee meeting dates are:
  - Thursday, November 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024
  - Thursday, March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025
  - Thursday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025
- Thank you all for submitting your data reports! We really appreciate the time it took to gather and report the data and we look forward to sharing out the results at a future commercial insurance carrier call!
- Malheur County Health Department began offering home visits on April 1, 2024.
- Polk and Lane counties anticipate they will begin offering home visits late 2024.
