Tracking Home Visiting Effectiveness in Oregon (THEO) is a data system that collects home visiting data, provides case management features, and tells the story of home visiting services.

Announcement: THEO Rollout postponed until 2021

The THEO rollout to Babies First!, CaCoon and Nurse Family Partnership programs is postponed until 2021. The postponement decision was made for the following reasons:

1. COVID-19 has impacted the capacity and priorities of local and state public health staff and agencies.
2. Functionality in THEO is being modified to improve support for programs. OHA is working with the vendor to implement needed changes.

Monthly status updates will be discontinued at this time. Once the COVID-19 response deescalates, and MCH staff have had the opportunity to revise the THEO rollout schedule, an update will be sent out and monthly communications about THEO will resume.
