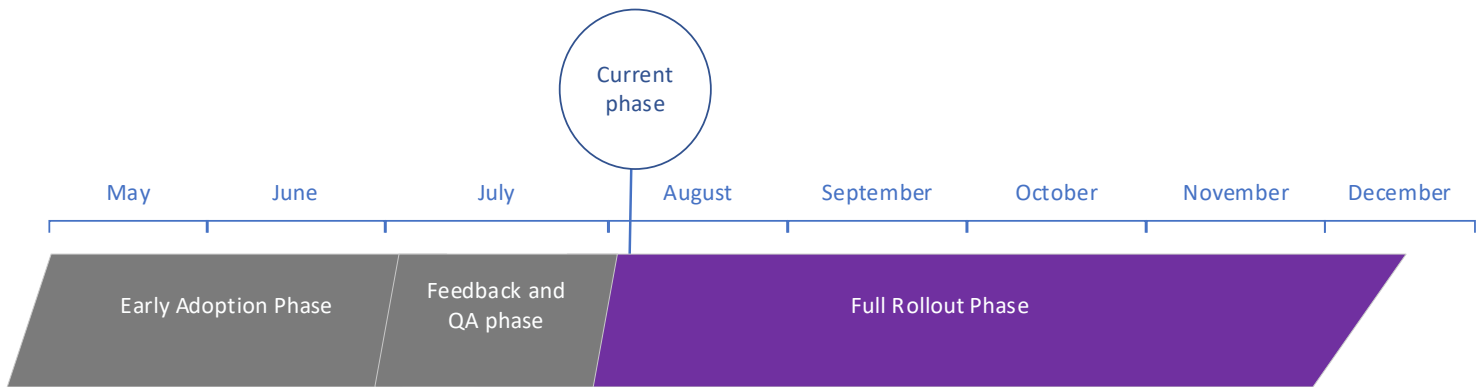
- The last day to use ORCHIDS data collection forms in the field is Friday, August 12, 2022.
