



## Universally Offered Newborn Nurse Home Visiting Program Reimbursement Advisory Committee Press Release

Date: January 20, 2023

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) announces the convening of the Universally offered Newborn Nurse Home Visiting Program's Reimbursement Advisory Committee ("Advisory Committee"). Senate Bill 1555 gives OHA the authority to define the requirements for reimbursement for health benefit places and the process of defining the reimbursement rate for Family Connects Oregon (FCO) services.

Administrative Rules (OARs) 333-006-0180 through 333-006-0190 designates OHA to convene a tenperson Advisory Committee consisting of various FCO stakeholders (e.g., health benefit plans, FCO service providers and community members) to provide subject matter expertise and input on the rate setting process and budget standards that will guide the FCO case rate starting July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025.

The call for committee members went out in early December 2022, with the final committee members notified of their acceptance by January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The first meeting will be Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Additional meetings and meeting objectives are as follows:
