- 110 Family Slots Malheur, Multnomah, Tillamook
- Coordinated entry

Development
2011-2013

- 237 family slots Jefferson, Lane, Lincoln, Morrow, Umatilla
- Community alignment, workforce development and TA, CQI and data system development

Expansion
2013-2015

- 501 family slots Clatsop, Jackson, Klamath, Marion, Yamhill
- Core knowledge standards and integration with early learning and health transformation

MIECHV Home Visiting in Oregon

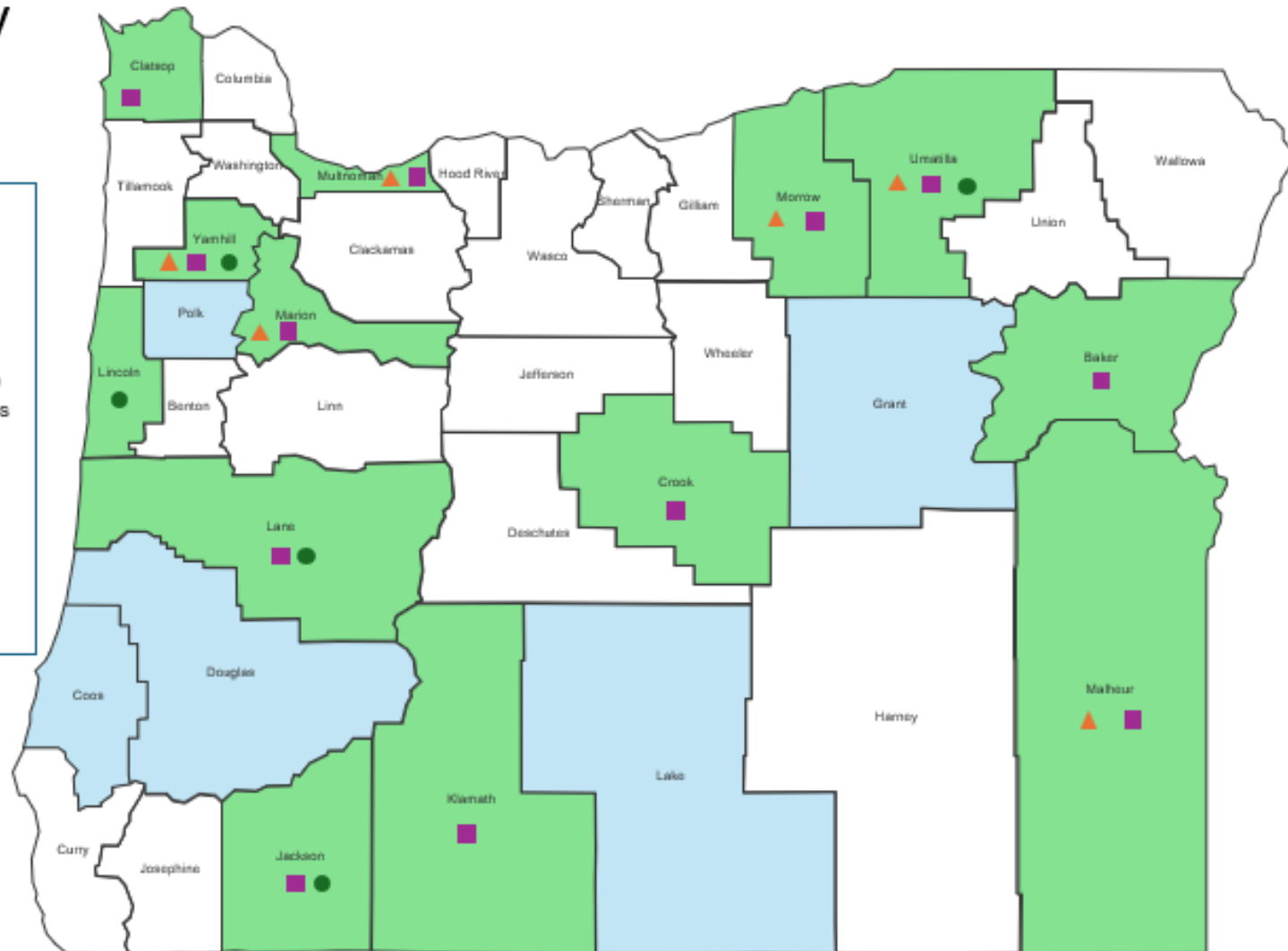
- 22 organizations providing/coordinating home visiting services at 23 locations in 13 Counties
- Oregon MIECHV enrollment capacity is 840 families
 - EHS: 119
 - HFA: 298
 - NFP: 423
