Objective

To provide commercial health benefit plan partners a monthly standardized update about the latest developments in Family Connects Oregon (FCO).

Status Update

- Last reminder! The 2025-2027 Family Connects Oregon Case Rate goes into effect on July 1, 2025.
 - Happy new fiscal year and new biennium!
 - Beginning July 1, 2025, the FCO case rate for commercial claims will be \$1856. The
 case rate for Pre-IHVs only is \$427. In the case of families with multiple infants (e.g.
 twins, triplets), the case rate is \$297 per additional infant.
 - Commercial insurance carriers will need to update their FCO Fee Schedules to reflect this rate increase. If you need OHA support, please reach out to us at oregon.uohv@odhsoha.oregon.gov.
- Our next commercial insurance carrier call will be on Tuesday, July 15 at 1:05p on Microsoft Teams.
- FCO Site Launch Updates
 - Lane County Public Health began offering services on November 1, 2024.
 - o Yamhill County Public Health began offering services on January 1, 2025.
 - o Polk County Health Department began offering services on February 1, 2025.
 - United Community Action Network (UCAN; Douglas County) began offering services on February 1, 2025.
 - South Coast is planning to offer services in Coos County starting in late 2025.
 - Multnomah County is planning to offer services starting in late 2025.

This Month In History!

- To celebrate 18 months of the monthly Commercial Insurance Carrier Status
 Update, we are adding a new segment! Just like on our bi-monthly call, I will share some fun historic facts!
 - June 3, 1937 The Duke of Windsor married Wallis Warfield Simpson in Monts, France. As King Edward VIII, he abdicated the British throne in December 1936 amid controversy to marry Wallis.
 - June 6, 1872 Pioneering feminist Susan B. Anthony was fined for voting in a presidential election in Rochester, NY.
 - June 13, 1966 The U.S. Supreme Court ruled 5-4 in the case of Miranda v. Arizona that an accused person must be apprised of certain rights before police questioning including the right to remain silent, that anything said can be used against them in a court of law and the right to have a defense attorney present during interrogation.
 - June 14, 1922 Warren G. Harding became the first U.S. President to broadcast a message over the radio to dedicate the Francis Scott Key Memorial in Baltimore. Maryland.
 - June 15, 1215 King John set his seal to Magna Carta.
 - June 18, 1815 On the fields near Waterloo in Central Belgium, 72,000
 French troops, led by Napoleon Bonaparte, suffered a crushing defeat from the Allied army of British, Dutch, Belgian and Prussian troops.
 - June 21, 1982 Prince William Arthur Philip Louis, heir to the British throne, is born in London to Prince Charles and Princess Diana.
 - June 26, 1945 The United Nations Charter was signed in San Francisco by 50 nations.
 - June 30, 1997 In Hong Kong, the flag of the British Crown Colony was
 officially lowered at midnight and replaced by a new flag representing China's
 sovereignty and the official transfer of power.
