### **Objective**

To provide commercial insurance carriers (CICs) a monthly standardized update about the latest developments in Family Connects Oregon (FCO).

## **Status Update**

- Winter 1:1s with carriers This upcoming winter, we would like to check in with each
  carrier. A separate email with dates and times will be sent to the government relations
  contacts. Please respond with your desired meeting time. Meeting agenda and items of
  discussion will be sent out a week before your meeting!
- Additional carrier contacts With the holidays fast approaching and people being out of the office, if you have another contact at your organization that works on the FCO project, please send their name and email address to oregon.uohv@odhsoha.oregon.gov.
- Our **first meeting** of 2026 will be on **Monday, March 9** at 2:05pm. Meeting agenda will go out a week before the meeting.
- As of July 1, 2025, carriers need to discontinue contracts with Crook County and transfer contracts over to Jefferson County, who will be serving the Crook County area.
  - Jefferson County is aware they do not need to list Crook County as a service area on contracts with commercial insurance carriers (CICs).
- The 2025-2027 Family Connects Oregon Case Rate went into effect on July 1, 2025.
  - Beginning July 1, 2025, the FCO <u>case rate</u> for commercial claims is \$1856. The
    case rate for Pre-IHVs only is \$427. In the case of families with multiple infants (e.g.
    twins, triplets), the case rate is \$297 per additional infant. Additional details can be
    found in the <u>FCO Coding Guidance</u>.
- FCO Site Launch Updates
  - o **Multnomah County** is planning to offer services in March 2026.
  - o Yamhill County Public Health began offering services on January 1, 2025.
  - o Polk County Health Department began offering services on February 1, 2025.
  - United Community Action Network (UCAN; Douglas County) began offering services on February 1, 2025.
