CIC Input Requested on updating FCO Billing Guidance

- We are seeking CIC input on the following excerpt re: CPT codes 99502 and 99501 in the updated Coding Guidance.
 - CPT Code 99502 "Home visit for newborn care and assessment, is the procedure code used for Family Connects Oregon claims. *Kaiser Permanente requests CPT Code 99501 be used for infants 30 days old or older on the date of the Integrated Home Visit.
