- As of July 1, 2025, carriers need to discontinue contracts with Crook County and transfer contracts over to Jefferson County, who will be serving the Crook County area.
- The 2025-2027 Family Connects Oregon Case Rate went into effect on July 1, 2025.
 - Beginning July 1, 2025, the FCO <u>case rate</u> for commercial claims is \$1856. The
 case rate for Pre-IHVs only is \$427. In the case of families with multiple infants (e.g.
 twins, triplets), the case rate is \$297 per additional infant. Additional details can be
 found in the <u>FCO Coding Guidance</u>.

- September 2, 1752 The British ended their use of the Julian calendar, switching instead to the Georgian calendar, resulting in a major adjustment as Wednesday, September 2, was followed by Thursday, September 14. The correction resulted in rioting by people who felt cheated and demanded the missing 11 days back.
- September 12, 1953 John F. Kennedy, 36, married Jacqueline Bouvier, 24, in a ceremony before 750 guests at St. Mary's Church in Newport, Rhode Island.
- September 15, 1984 Prince Henry Charles Albert David, known as Prince Harry, is born to Prince Charles and Princess Diana at St. Mary's Hospital in London.
- September 26, 1960 The first-ever televised presidential debate occurred between presidential candidates John F. Kennedy and Richard M. Nixon.
- September 28, 1066 The Norman Conquest of England began as Duke William of Normandy landed at Pevensey, Sussex.
