

Number of ACEs among adults in Oregon




44% of adult Oregonians experienced 2 or more ACEs during childhood; 22% experience 4 or more.



Prevalence of ACEs types among adults in Oregon




Adults in Oregon with high ACEs score (4+)













Adults in Oregon with 4 or more ACEs are:
