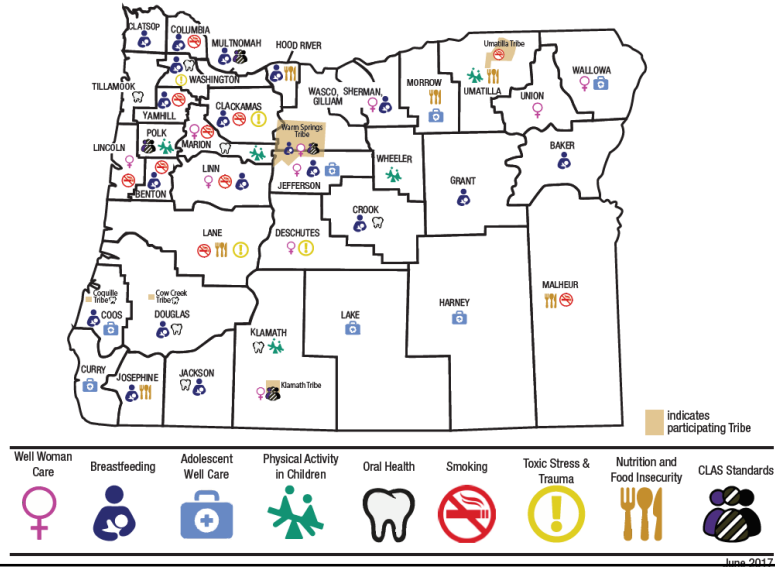

Block Grant Updates: Block Grant 3.0 and beyond

Block Grant 3.0

- Beginning 2016, changes in federal guidance, increased focus and accountability

Where we are in Oregon 2 years into BG 3.0

- Oregon selected priorities based on 2016 Needs Assessment:
- Developed evidence-based/informed strategies for each priority
- Developed a new system for local grantees to:
 - focus Title V work on the Title V priorities,
 - select among the strategies,
 - develop and implement locally-relevant activities
 - plan, measure and report Title V work

Oregon's MCH Title V priorities: 2016 -2020

National Priorities	State Specific Priorities
Well women care	Trauma, ACEs and Resiliency
Breastfeeding	Culturally and linguistically responsive services
Physical activity for children	Food insecurity
Adolescent well care	
Oral health (pregnant women and children)	
Smoking (pregnant women and children)	

What we're hearing from our Federal partners

- MCH Title V Block Grant relatively stable
- Reauthorization of MIECHV, CHIP, and other programs supports Title V work
- AMCHP advocacy for future funding levels

Block Grant Updates: What's next?

– Due April 1, 2018:

Title V plans for Title V work July 1 2018 – June 30 2019 (SFY 2019)

– Note:

- **No report will due in April** – just a plan for next year's work
- Title V online plan/report form has been updated to reflect the revised strategies and provide drop-down measures (per Maria's talk)
- **Title V annual report** for work currently underway (July 1 2017 – June 30 2018) will be due in **September 2018**.

Block Grant Updates: What's next?

– **Next 5 year MCH Needs Assessment** will begin Spring 2019 and will set the new Title V priorities for Oregon for 2021 – 2025.

- Federal guidelines for Title V are being refined and will inform the selection of Title V priorities coming out of the next needs assessment.
- Local grantees will be an important part of the needs assessment planning and implementation, so let us know if you want to be involved 😊
