

HELP GETTING A RIDE

If you are enrolled in the Reproductive Health Access Fund (RHAF), you can get free rides to receive reproductive health care.

Not sure if you are enrolled in RHAF? Call the clinic where your appointment is scheduled and ask if you are enrolled in RHAF.

What kind of ride can I get?

You will usually get a ride by a local ride service, bus, or taxi. In some cases, you may get paid back for travel costs like gas, meals, and lodging. It's required that enrollees get approval in advance if they seek reimbursement for such costs.

Is there any cost to me?

No. You should never be billed for rides to or from covered services.

How do I schedule a ride?

At least two days before your appointment, call the non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) company for your county (listed on the back of this card). If you want, someone you know can call for you.

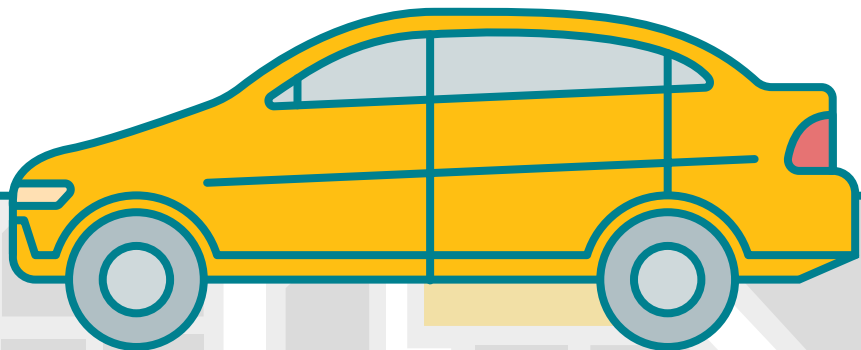
What if I need to get to an appointment today or tomorrow?

Call the NEMT company and they will try to help. If you call less than two days before your appointment, they may not be able to provide a ride.

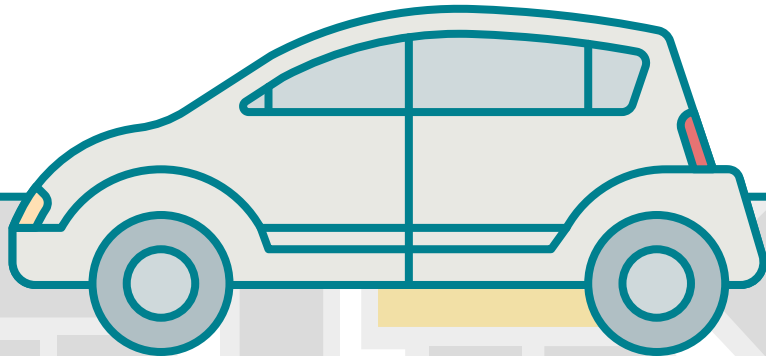
