- All youth who live in Oregon and are between the ages of 15-19 are eligible to apply.
- Selected members are paid \$45/hour for their service and eligible to serve a 2-year term.
- Members are expected to commit up to 8 hours per month on YAC meeting and public health related projects.
- The 2026-2027 cohort will feature three ongoing subcommittee opportunities: youth data, policy, and access to clinical preventative services.
