

## RH Program vs Screenwise Eligibility

	RH Program	Screenwise
Age	No age requirement. Must be able to get someone pregnant or become pregnant.	Age 21-49 and needing breast or cervical cancer diagnostic services.
	Patient not eligible if cannot get pregnant or get someone else pregnant.	Age 50 or older and needing breast or cervical cancer screening or diagnostic services.
Residency	Not required to live in Oregon	A patient must live or intend to live in Oregon.
Income	A patient must have an <b>individual</b> income at or below 250% of Federal Poverty Level.	A patient must have a <b>household</b> income at or below 250% of Federal Poverty Level.
Insurance Status	A patient may be uninsured or underinsured. <i>Patients with OHP are disqualified from the RH Program</i>	A patient must either have no health insurance OR have health insurance, but not enough to cover their needs.

## RH Program vs Screenwise Crosswalk

Question/Topic	RH Program	Screenwise
Well Woman Exams	<b>Yes</b> , visit must have reproductive health component.	<b>Yes</b> , patient must be 50 years of age or older.
Cervical Diagnostic Procedures -Colpo -LEEP -EMB -ECC	<b>No</b> , screen patient for Screenwise Program.	<b>Yes</b> , covered for patients 21 years old or older if they meet other eligibility criteria.
Breast Services	<b>No</b> , screen patient for Screenwise Program.	<b>Yes</b> , screening and diagnostic services are covered for patients 50 years of age or older. Only diagnostic procedures are covered for patients between the ages 21-49. See FAQ for more information.
Birth Control	<b>Yes</b> , all forms of birth control are covered including emergency contraceptives.	<b>No</b> , screen patients for RH Program.
STI Screening	<b>Yes</b> , all STI screening is included in bundled rate except Chlamydia and Gonorrhea are reimbursed on top of bundled rate.	<b>No</b> , screen patients for RH Program.
STI Treatment for patients only:	<b>Yes</b> , only covered for Chlamydia and Gonorrhea treatment.	<b>No</b> , screen patients for RH Program.
Sterilization services	<b>Yes</b> , refer out*.	<b>No</b> , screen patients for RH Program.
Abortion service referral	<b>Yes</b> , information given to patient**	<b>No</b> , screen patients for RH Program.

## RH Program vs Screenwise FAQ

### **Are we able to enroll patients in either program retroactively?**

RH Program does not allow patients to enroll retroactively, if they were not enrolled on the date of service they will not cover the visit. As stated in page 2 of the Screenwise enrollment, the program allows patients enroll

### **If a patient is scheduled for a WWE should we enroll the patient under RH Program or Screenwise?**

Patients between the ages 21-49 should enroll for the RH Program if they meet eligibility requirements. If they are 50 years old or older and are not requesting birth control, screen for Screenwise eligibility requirements,

### **Are screening paps covered by Screenwise if they have history of abnormal paps?**

Screening Paps will not be covered by Screenwise for patients between the ages 21-49, regardless of history of abnormal, but will be covered by the RH Program if reproductive health component is discussed.

### **If a pap result is abnormal and additional diagnostic procedures are indicated, will either program cover?**

Screenwise will cover diagnostic procedures, such as colposcopies, cervical biopsies, endocervical curettage, conization of the cervix, and diagnostic LEEPs for patients older than 21 years of age. RH Program does not cover

### **What if patient is scheduled for a Screenwise eligible visit but is requesting to have IUD inserted the same day,**

Yes, both can be done the same day but will require to document in 2 different encounters. The Screenwise visit encounter and a separate Supply Only encounter checked in under RH Program to request reimbursement for

### **Does either program cover screening breast services (ex. mammogram)?**

RH Program does not cover screening breast services. If a patient is 50 years or older Screenwise will cover both

### **If diagnostic breast services are indicated which program will cover?**

Screenwise will cover diagnostic breast services but will not cover the office visit if they are between the ages of 21-49. They will need to complete Screenwise enrollment forms but coverage should not be added in EPIC. If 50 or older, Screenwise will cover diagnostic procedures and office visit. Screenwise should be added in Registration
