Auditor's Corner

The RH Program must adhere to a variety of on-going audit processes to ensure the provision of quality services and accurate enrollment and billing practices. This section of the newsletter is to help providers understand the auditing process.

Chart Documentation

When chart audits are conducted we are looking to see if chart notes support the type of visit and the visit level billed to the RH Program (low, moderate or high). The medical services marked on the CVR must be clearly documented in the visit chart notes.

Enrollment Forms

It is of utmost importance that RH Program Enrollment Forms are complete and accurate. Any information missing from the Form can cause the client enrollment to be terminated. Of special importance are the client signature and signature date, household size and income information, and all yes/no questions. Please be sure to review the Enrollment Form when the client is still at the clinic so that any missing or incorrect information can be supplied or corrected and initialed by the client.
