- Multi or prenatal vitamins containing folic acid can be billed to RHAF.
- STI medication quantities account for partner treatment for up to two partners when needed.
- Do not bill RHAF if you are dispensing STI treatment medications supplied by the state STD Program.

Unit price should be your agency's **acquisition cost** for supplies. Agencies that qualify for 340B drug pricing should bill lower amounts than the maximum rates listed here.
