



Clinic Moving and Expansion Grant Application Process

The State WIC program provides up to \$5,000 in funding to support local agencies in creating trauma-informed waiting rooms and shared spaces for both participants and staff. This funding is intended to help agencies design environments that promote calm, safety, and dignity for all who enter. Currently, the State will handle the purchasing, and items will be delivered to your agency (**updates to process coming in July 2026**)

Examples of some allowable purchases may include but not limited to:

- waiting room toys,
- furnishings that create a more accessible environment,
- Trauma-informed artwork,
- ambient noise reduction equipment,
- visual/auditory dividers to enhance confidentiality,
- and scales to meet special needs.

This grant aims to foster welcoming, supportive spaces that reflect trauma-informed principles and improve overall program experience by helping local agencies cover costs that are not typically approved.

PLEASE NOTE: This application is a request for additional funding, and not permission to spend current NSA dollars on improvements. Purchasing is very limited.

How to apply

The clinic must complete an application describing the project and detailing the items they are requesting the State to purchase.

What are the qualifying criteria:

The local agency must be moving or expanding clinic operations.
