Level 1 Training Checklist

Use this checklist to keep track and plan training for non-certifying staff. This includes staff shared with other programs.

Staff who perform lab functions or take measurements, but do not complete certifications complete this program and the additional anthropometric courses listed.

Workday Learning

All training is in Workday Learning. PDF modules may be completed using a digital file or printed. All PDF files are “fillable” and allow note taking. Printed versions of PDF modules may be ordered through Oregon WIC Shopify.
