Participating in WIC supports the long-term health of women, infants, children and families. WIC is proven to support longer pregnancies and positive birth outcomes<sup>1</sup>.

For children, the American Academy of Pediatrics identifies three foundations of healthy child development:

- Stable, Responsive Relationships
- Safe, Supportive Environments
- Appropriate Nutrition<sup>2</sup>

#### HEALTHY FOOD ACCESS

To be a WIC store, it must carry:

- At least 8 kinds of fresh fruits and vegetables
- Whole grain products
- Lowfat milk
- Lowfat yogurt
- Canned/dried beans
