


Civil Rights Job Aid

Protected Classes defined:



Age—A person's real or perceived age in years.

Race—describes physical characteristics

National Origin – A person's association with being from a particular country or part of the world.

Sex—A person's sex or sexual orientation.

Color—A person's skin color or complexion.

Disability – covered as defined by the American's with Disabilities Act.

Information that helps when a complaint is filed:

What happened during the incident

When it occurred, or when they found out about it

Where the incident occurred

Why is this a potential violation, what protected classes may have been discriminated against

<u>Documents</u> that are related to the incident (includes photos, screenshots

Witness information of anyone who may have been present during incident
