
Update on our new data system:

# 19 calorie formulas switching to 20 calories



## Similac Sensitive - no MDF needed

- Switching from 19 to 20 calories per ounce
- Milk-based formula, 2% lactose
- Similar to Gentlease



## Similac Total Comfort - no MDF needed

- Switching from 19 to 20 calories per ounce
- Milk-based formula, 100% whey protein, partially hydrolyzed, 2% lactose
- Similar to Gentlease, Soothe



## Similac for Spit Up - MDF required

- Switching from 19 to 20 calories per ounce
- Milk-based formula, added rice starch, 20% whey, trace lactose
- Similar to Enfamil AR
