





- Oregon WIC update: Tools for requesting medical formulas
- Formula shortages continue to be a challenge across the state due to the Abbott recall and supply chain shortages. If you work with WIC families, here are tools to assist you and your staff:
- Oregon WIC has temporarily added <u>alternative formulas to</u> <u>assist families with finding formula to purchase with their</u> <u>WIC benefits</u> (short URL: <a href="https://go.usa.gov/xzCCe">https://go.usa.gov/xzCCe</a>).
- Providers are asked to list all medically appropriate alternatives when completing the <u>Oregon Medical Documentation Form</u> (short URL: <a href="http://tinyurl.com/WIC-636">http://tinyurl.com/WIC-636</a>).

# Providers asked to list all acceptable formulas on Medical Documentation Form

**Action requested**: Please list all acceptable formulas on the MDF when requesting a medical formula from WIC. This will prevent delays in providing infants and children with the medical formulas they need. Below is a table of the medical formula types and names of alternative products to include on the MDF.

Formula type	List all formula names on the Medical Documentation Form	
Premature discharge	EnfaCare or NeoSure
