## 2-7 Breastfeeding Level 1 online course

One of the four main services that WIC provides is breastfeeding promotion and support. Breastfeeding supports the health of our participants and community in a number of different ways.

## What you need to do

- Work with your training supervisor to determine a time to complete the Breastfeeding Level 1 online course. There are 2 modules in this course. It takes about 1.5 hours to complete both. Date and time
