

## 4-15 Responsive Parenting and WIC online course

This course identifies what influences parenting behaviors, styles of parenting, how parenting affects children's development. You must complete this training before certifying children.

### What you need to do

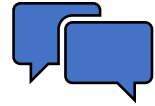
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1. Work with your training supervisor to determine a time to complete the ***Responsive Parenting and WIC*** online course. It takes about 1.5 hours to complete.
