

# Group NE Levels of Involvement



<b>Role and</b> (NE Model Domain)	<b>Skills and abilities</b>
<b>1. Facilitates groups</b> (Facilitation – Skills, Methods, Strategies; Facilitator knowledge; Environment)	Able to <i>demonstrate</i> use of participant centered skills, methods, and strategies, and <i>utilizes</i> content knowledge of the subject when facilitating groups
<b>2. Adapts existing NE session plans</b> (Preparation)	Able to <i>review</i> existing materials, <i>apply</i> PCE principles, and <i>adapt</i> materials and activities to make them more participant centered
<b>3. Develops new PC learning activities and session plans</b> (Preparation)	Able to <i>design</i> new participant centered NE sessions and <i>analyze</i> learning activities to determine if they meet identified learning objectives
<b>4. Evaluates NE and assesses need</b> (Leadership and Support)	Able to <i>estimate</i> the need for specific NE offerings, <i>measure</i> the success of existing NE sessions, and <i>plan</i> NE that meets the needs of the participants in your agency
<b>5. Champion/Advocate</b> (Leadership and Support)	Able to <i>advocate</i> for agency plans and policies that best address the NE needs and health outcomes of participants
