Breast Pump Issuance screens now include all electric breast pumps

All electric breast pumps now show on the Family Summary Screen (FSS). This change helps local agency staff monitor the most recently issued single-user pump.

Steps to view a participant's full breast pump issuance history:

- Navigate to the BF Tracking Tab
- Click Breast Pump Issuance sub tab

Note: Multi-user pumps currently on loan will display on the FSS. Previously issued single-user electric pumps will not display.

Image: Hygeia Single User Pumps (Pro, Evolve, or Express)





Image: Personal Double Electric Pump (PumpInStyle)

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Medical Documentation Updates

One month allowance for Medical Formulas ends

A written Medical Documentation Form (MDF) or verbal order is required to issue a medical formula, nutritional, or other qualifying supplemental food to a participant. TWIST will no longer allow one month of issuance of a special medical formula without medical documentation. See Policy 765 for details.

What is changing


TWIST will not allow staff to issue a medical formula, nutritional, or other food that requires an MDF without entering the MDF or a verbal order.

Do not assign a formula, nutritional, or food that requires an MDF if you do not have a written or verbal order. You may issue foods that do not require an MDF.

Verbal Orders

Staff may obtain and use verbal orders for medical documentation while the MDF is being completed by the prescribing physician. Verbal orders allow staff to issue two weeks of a formula or nutritional.

How to enter a verbal order in TWIST



- 1. Enter the date you received the verbal order in the "Start Date" field on the Medical Documentation screen.
- Enter an end date of two weeks from that date in the "End Date" field.
 The date range must be within the current month.
 If two weeks is in the next month, the "End Date" must be the last date of the month.
 - For example, two weeks after a start date of 08/20/2025 is 09/03/2025. Enter the following in TWIST:

Start date: 08/20/2025 End Date: 08/31/2025

- 3. Best practice is to include healthcare provider name for follow up.
- 4. Enter "VO" for verbal order in the Notes field.

TWIST Fix:

Medical Documentation no longer disappears in the first month

A fix has been completed. Medical Documentation entered on a starting date that is not the first of the month no longer disappears in the current benefit month.

Risk Updates

Changes to Risk 141 and 201

Changes have been made to Risk 141 - Low Birth Weight and Risk 201 - Low Hemoglobin/Hematocrit in this release. All certifying staff need to be aware of these changes starting August 18, 2025.

- TWIST now assigns a very low hemoglobin or hematocrit as Risk 201B which is high risk. Staff no longer need to manually change risk level.
- TWIST now assigns Low Birth Weight as high risk from birth through 11 months (Risk 141A) and medium risk for 12-24 months (Risk 141B).
