One-year certifications and the Mid-Certification Health Assessment

TWIST User Manual: Chapter 3, Section 8, Lesson 803: Updating Client Information Mid-Certification

Certification periods – Policy 600

- Breastfeeding adults can be certified up to one year from their baby's date of birth.
- Infants enrolled from 0 to 6 months of age are certified until the month of their first birthday.
- Infants enrolled from 7 to 12 months of age will be certified for six months.
- Children will be certified for twelve months until the month of their fifth birthday.
- Nutrition Education (NE) must be provided quarterly during these certification periods.

Mid-Certification Health Assessment (MCHA) - Policy 646

- Breastfeeding adults and infants will be scheduled for a MCHA between five and eight months after delivery.
- Children will be scheduled for a MCHA six months after the certification start date.
- TWIST automatically generates mid-certification appointment requests for an **MW** (mid-cert for adults), **MI** (mid-cert for infants), or an **MC** (mid-cert for children).
- Do not withhold benefits if the MCHA is not completed on time or participant refuses appointment.

Sample NE and multiple month benefit issuance for low-risk infant, breastfeeding adult, and child

Scenario: Adult was on WIC while pregnant. They fully breastfeed until infant starts supplemental formula at 3 months of age. Adult continues to mostly breastfeed to 1 year postpartum. Adult enrolls 2-year-old child the same month that infant was born.
