


# TWIST Updates for 12/3/2018



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
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The TWIST release for December has been changed to 12/3! Please note this change.

# A new safeguard will prevent issuance of formulas that are no longer available

## Watch for the “F” formula issuance error on the Family Summary Screen (FSS)

- An "F" (for formula) will show instead of a checkbox on the FSS when a formula has been assigned in months after that formula has been end dated.
- The "F" works just like the “M” or “R” codes on the FSS and prevents issuance.
- The “F” safeguards against accidental issuance of formulas that have been end-dated (for example the old bid soy formula Gerber Good Start Soy).
- If there are "F"s instead of checkboxes, you will also see a message at the bottom of the screen reminding you to change to a current formula - **FORMULA ERROR, assign new bid formula for months with "F"**
- **It is easy to fix this error!** Go back to the Food Package Assignment screen and assign the new formula for any months with the “F” message. When you return to the FSS you will have checkboxes and be able to issue benefits.



## New with this TWIST release

### February benefits will now end on the last day in February

In the past February benefits were required to be extended to a full 30 days after the first of the month, which caused some confusion when the benefits continued into March. The rules have changed and we are no longer required to give 30 days to use February benefits.



Benefits issued in February will expire on February 28 and will not overlap into March. The rules around benefits issued to new participants in the last 5 days of the month, remain the same.

### Head Circumference graphs updated

You can now view age-adjusted *Head Circumference graphs* for preterm infants and children under 24 months.

### Updates to TWIST reports

The *Daily Clinic Schedule for Individual Appointments* report will now correctly show the full temporary WIC ID numbers.
