Which formulas can I buy?

Due to the formula recall, Oregon WIC participants who receive formula can temporarily use their WIC EBT cards to purchase specific alternative options. <u>Click here to see a list of allowed formula alternatives.</u>


If you need to purchase formula using your WIC benefits:

- We are once again starting to see Abbot powder formulas in stores. If you find the formula listed on your benefit, you can purchase it with your eWIC card.
- If you feel uncertain about purchasing Abbot products, check the lot number as shown below to check against recalled products.
- If you cannot find the formula listed on your benefit or any of the <u>alternative formulas</u>, please call your <u>local WIC clinic</u> to explore options.

Which products were recalled?

In February, Abbott issued a recall of several powder infant formulas. If you have formula purchased prior to February 18, 2022, please check to see if it was recalled. To do so,

- Enter the lot number into the Similac Recall site: www.similacrecall.com or
- Call 1-800-986-8540



Affected products have lot numbers with all three of the following:

- The first two digits between 22 through 37, and
- A code that has K8, SH, or Z2, and
- An expiration date of 04/01/2022 or later.

 If the formula you have is *not* affected by the recall, it is safe to use.

If the formula you have was recalled:

• Do **NOT** use the formula.

Options to exchange or replace it are:

- Call Abbott directly at 1-800-986-8540.
- Check with your store. WIC has temporarily approved additional options for replacing recalled formula, which may include, but are not limited to, the same product, a substitute product, cash refund/store credit to buy a different formula.
