What this report tells you:

Shows the percent of the certified caseload which was not issued benefits – this is the difference between your certified caseload and participating caseload. It show the percentage by month, for the past 12 months.

Why use this report:

A percentage ≤4% is ideal for maintaining your caseload. A lower percentage means a smaller amount of participants are without benefits. Because participants are automatically terminated after 2 months without issued benefits, it is important to reschedule their appointments and issue benefits to keep them on WIC. Use the **Participants with No Benefits Issued** register for more detailed information.
