### CLAIMS AND BILLING UPDATE

- **Please include the patient’s full name when submitting claims and forms** - This ensures accuracy of enrollment and reduces the chance of duplicate entries which can cause patients to be billed accidentally for services covered by ScreenWise.
- **CPT List** – The 2017 reimbursement schedule expected on February 1st is delayed. Our program is still waiting for the final OHP fee-for-service fee schedule. Due to this delay, all claims with a date of service on or prior to 2/28/2017 will be processed with our current reimbursement schedule. We will send an update to all providers as soon as more information is available on how claims with a 3/1/2017 date of service onwards will be processed.

- **Please keep enrollment forms on file** – Just as a reminder, per OAR 333-010-0115 (4) enrollment forms should be kept on file for a minimum of 4 years.
