

ScreenWise Program Update: July 2017

Program Updates

- **Referrals:** If you are referring a ScreenWise patient to an ancillary provider please remember to label referral paperwork clearly so that the ancillary provider knows to bill the ScreenWise program. Failure to label referrals can lead to patients being billed for services, duplicate paperwork or claims, and extra work for all parties.
 - We have created ScreenWise referral and “next steps” graphics that can be utilized to create stamps for ease of labeling paperwork. If you would like to use them please contact our Quality Assurance Coordinator, Tessa Jaqua at tessa.r.jaqua@dhsosha.state.or.us
- **Enrollment forms:** If enrollment forms are submitted without complete information they will be returned immediately. Submitting incomplete enrollment forms delays a patient’s enrollment into the ScreenWise program. This results in delays in claims pay-outs and increases the likelihood of a patient being billed for services. **Please double check ALL paperwork before you submit it to the program.**
- **Final outcomes/diagnosis:** Please send or include the final outcome/diagnosis on all breast, cervical, and cardiovascular screenings as soon as you have received the information.
- **MDE clean up:** Our program will be reviewing patient data for submission to the CDC in October. As part of this review we will be sending out requests to our provider community to complete screening and diagnosis information. Please be on the lookout for these requests in your inboxes in the next month.
